The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces that Public Informational Meeting will be held regarding the rehabilitation of the bridge connecting Portsmouth, NH-Kittery, ME (Br. No. 247/084) also known as the Memorial Bridge, carrying U.S. Route 1 over the Piscataqua River, jointly-owned by the States of New Hampshire and Maine. A separate approach bridge on the New Hampshire side, carrying U.S. Route 1 (Scott Avenue) over Daniel Street (Br. No. 246/083), owned by the City of Portsmouth, will also be replaced. A separate approach bridge on the Maine side, carrying U.S. Route 1 over Piscataqua River (Br. No. 5276), owned by the State of Maine, will also be rehabilitated.

The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 29, 2008, at 7:00 pm, at the Portsmouth City Hall, in the Eileen Dondero Foley Council Chambers, 1 Junkins Avenue, Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Department staff will be available prior to the presentation for informal discussions beginning at 6:30 pm.

The purpose of this meeting is to update Officials and the general public on the latest design for the Memorial Bridge and traffic control information for the project.

It is hoped you will plan to attend this meeting.
